PROTOCOL BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE UNITED KINGDOM, FRANCE AND IRAQ FOR THE TRANSFER FROM THE UNITED KINGDOM TO IRAQ OF CERTAIN RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS UNDER THE SAN REMO OIL AGREEMENT OF APRIL 24, 1920, AND THE CONVENTION BETWEEN THE UNITED KINGDOM AND FRANCE OF DECEMBER 23, 1920, RELATING TO MANDATES IN THE MIDDLE EAST.

Geneva, October 10, 1932.

Protocol between the Governments of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, of the French Republic and of the Kingdom of Iraq.

THE Governments of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, of the French Republic and of the Kingdom of Iraq, respectively represented by the undersigned plenipotentiaries, who have communicated to one another their full powers, are agreed in recognising that the rights and obligations devolving upon the Government of the United Kingdom under the San Remo Oil Agreement of the 24th April, 1920,⁽¹⁾ and the convention signed at Paris on the 23rd December, 1920,⁽²⁾ relating to certain points connected with the mandates for Syria and the Lebanon, Palestine and Mesopotamia, are henceforth transferred to the Government of Iraq in so far as the provisions of those instruments relate to Iraq.

Done in triplicate, in English and French, at Geneva, the 10th day of October, 1932.
