EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN HIS MAJESTY'S GOVERNMENT IN THE UNITED KINGDOM AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THE NETHERLANDS PROLONGING THE ANGLO-NETHERLANDS MONETARY AGREEMENT OF 7th SEPTEMBER, 1945

Your Excellency,

6th September, 1948.

I HAVE the honour to propose to your Excellency that, in pursuance of the arrangements discussed between the representatives of the two Governments in London, the Monetary Agreement of the 7th September, 1945,(1) between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Royal Netherlands Government which, under Article 12 thereof, is due to terminate on the 7th September, 1948, unless the two Governments agree otherwise, shall be continued for a further period of one year from the latter date, subject to the following modification:—

Having regard to the provision in paragraph 7 of the arrangements for the Settlement of War-time Debts which were agreed in an Exchange of Letters of the 11th March, 1948,(2) between the two Governments, the references to an "additional sum" in Article 2 (ii) of the Monetary Agreement shall be deleted and the Agreement shall have effect as so modified.

2. If the Royal Netherlands Government agree to these proposals, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and your reply in that sense shall be regarded as constituting an Agreement between the two Governments.
