The Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs to the Danish Ambassador

Foreign Office,

Your Excellency, 10th November, 1948.

In Article 9 of the Angle Danish Monetary, Agreement of 16th August

In Article 9 of the Anglo-Danish Monetary Agreement of 16th August, 1945,(1) it was provided that the Agreement should not apply to the Faroe Islands until a date to be agreed between the two Contracting Governments.

- 2. I now have the honour to state that in discussions between representatives of Denmark and the United Kingdom it has been proposed that the provisions of the Anglo-Danish Monetary Agreement of 16th August, 1945, should apply to the Faroe Islands, as provided for in Article 9 thereof, with effect from 10th November, 1948.
- 3. His Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland have approved this proposal. I shall be grateful if your Excellency will inform me whether the Royal Danish Government likewise approve this proposal. I suggest that the Note from your Excellency informing me of the approval of the Royal Danish Government should, together with the present Note, be regarded as constituting an Agreement between the two Governments to this effect.
