Your Excellency,

I have the honour to propose to your Excellency that, in view of the new parities which have been established for the Netherlands guilder and the pound sterling, the Agreement of the 7th September, 1945(1), between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great, Britain and Northern Ireland and the Royal Netherlands Government, which was amended by notes exchanged on the 12th-16th September, 1946(2), and the 6th September, 1948(3), and was extended by notes exchanged on the 6th September, 1949(4), should be further

amended as follows:--

In Article I (i) the figure 10.64 = £1' shall be substituted for the figure 10.691 = £1 and in Article 2 (i) (a) and (b) the figure 106,400,000 shall be substituted for the figure 106,900,000 guilders.

I have the honour to propose also that these amendments should be

regarded as having come into effect on the 21st September, 1949.

If the Royal Netherlands Government agree to these proposals, I have the honour to suggest that the present note and your reply in that sense shall be regarded as constituting an agreement between the two Governments.
