London, 20th January, 1950.

In order to provide for the continued operation of the United States Educational Commission in the United Kingdom established pursuant to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the United States of America signed in London on 22nd September, 1948,⁽¹⁾ I have the honor to propose that, the Government of the United Kingdom shall make funds available for the purposes of the said Agreement, in addition to the sum mentioned in paragraph (a) of Article 2 thereof, by deposit in the United Kingdom in the name of the Treasurer of the United States of a sum in pounds sterling not exceeding the equivalent of the sum of \$2,000,000 in United States currency in amounts and at times requested by the Government of the United States.

If the Government of the United Kingdom agree to the above proposal, I have the honor further to propose that this Note together with your Excellency's reply in that sense shall constitute an agreement between our respective Governments.
