**EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM AND THE GOVERNMENT OF LUXEMBOURG, DELETING SINGAPORE AND THE FEDERATION OF MALAYA FROM THE LIST OF TERRITORIES COVERED BY THE VISA ABOLITION AGREEMENT**

Your Excellency,

In my Note of 26th October, 1948,<sup>(1)</sup> I had the honour to inform you that His Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom had decided to extend to Luxembourg subjects travelling to the territories named in the Annex to that Note the provisions of the agreement embodied in the Notes exchanged between your Excellency and myself on 14th February, 1947,<sup>(2)</sup> which abolished the visa requirement for Luxembourg subjects travelling to the United Kingdom. Among the territories named in the said Annex were Singapore and the Federation of Malaya.

Circumstances have unfortunately recently arisen in Singapore and the Federation of Malaya which necessitate the reimposition for the time being of the visa requirement for all foreign nationals proceeding to these territories. It is with regret that I therefore have to inform your Excellency that, as from 24th August, 1950, Luxembourg subjects will require visas for the purpose of travelling to Singapore and the Federation of Malaya.

I have the honour to request that your Excellency will be good enough to acknowledge receipt of this Note.

I have the honour to acknowledge with thanks receipt of your Excellency's letter of 10th August advising me that, as from 24th August, 1950, Luxembourg subjects will require Visas for the purpose of travelling to Singapore and the Federation of Malaya. These territories have, therefore, been deleted from the Annex attached to your Excellency's Note of 26th October, 1948.
