Berne, 2nd October, 1951.

I have the honour, upon instructions from His Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, to propose that the Monetary Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Swiss Government of 12th March, 1946,⁽¹⁾ as extended and modified by the Exchanges of Notes between those Governments of 25th February and 3rd March, 1949,⁽²⁾ of 4th March, 1950,⁽³⁾ 10th November, 1950,⁽⁴⁾ 10th March, 1951,⁽⁵⁾ and 9th June, 1951,⁽⁶⁾ shall be extended for a further period of five months from 11th October, 1951.

If the Swiss Government agree to this proposal I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and your reply in that sense shall be regarded as constituting an Agreement between the two Governments.
