Sir,

I have the honour to propose that the Sterling Payments Agreement between the Government of the Polish People's Republic and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland signed in London on 2nd March, 1948,<sup>(1)</sup> and last prolonged until the 9th June, 1954,<sup>(2)</sup> in accordance with an Exchange of Notes between the two Governments, shall be deemed to have continued in force after 9th June, 1954, and shall remain in force until 9th September, 1954.

2. If the Government of the United Kingdom agrees to this proposal, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and your reply to that effect shall be regarded as constituting an Agreement between the two Governments.

Your Excellency,

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your Excellency's Note of the 11th of June proposing that the Sterling Payments Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of Poland, signed in London on the 2nd of March, 1948, and last prolonged until the 9th of June, 1954, in accordance with an Exchange of Notes between the two Governments, shall be deemed to have continued in force after the 9th of June, 1954, and shall remain in force until the 9th of September, 1954.

In reply I have the honour to inform you that the Government of the United Kingdom accept this proposal of the Polish Government and will regard your Note and this reply as constituting an Agreement between the two Governments.
