**TEXT OF NOTES FROM HER MAJESTY'S GOVERNMENT IN
THE UNITED KINGDOM TO THE DANISH, ICELANDIC,
ITALIAN, LUXEMBOURG, NETHERLANDS, NORWEGIAN,
SWEDISH AND SWISS GOVERNMENTS REIMPOSING THE
VISA REQUIREMENT FOR THEIR RESPECTIVE NATIONALS
TRAVELLING TO CYPRUS**

Sir,

In his Note of the 26th of October, 1948,⁽¹⁾ the late Mr. Ernest Bevin had the honour to inform His Excellency Count Eduard Reventlow that Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom had decided to extend to Danish subjects travelling to the territories named in the Annex to that Note, the provisions of the Agreement embodied in the Notes exchanged between His Excellency and Mr. Attlee on the 20th of March, 1947,⁽²⁾ which abolished the visa requirement for Danish subjects travelling to the United Kingdom. Among the territories named in the said Annex was Cyprus.

In view of the present position in the Middle East the Government of Cyprus have thought it necessary to reimpose for the time being the visa requirement for all foreign nationals proceeding to Cyprus. It is with regret that I therefore have to inform you that as from the 12th of November, 1956, Danish subjects will require visas for the purpose of travelling to Cyprus.

I have the honour to request that you will be good enough to acknowledge the receipt of this Note.
