Sir,

I have the honor to refer to the Exchange of Notes of June 5, 1956,<sup>(1)</sup> as amended by the Exchanges of Notes of March 13, 1957,<sup>(2)</sup> and June 27, 1957,<sup>(3)</sup> relating to the sale of tobacco by the United States Government and the construction of housing and/or community facilities of the United Kingdom Government. I am now authorized to propose that the amount agreed in paragraph I of the Memorandum of Understanding attached to the Note of June 5, 1956, as amended, be increased to \$23 million of tobacco.

If this proposal meets with the approval of the Government of the United Kingdom, this Note and your affirmative reply will constitute an Agreement between our two Governments, which shall enter into force on the date of your reply.
