EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF POLAND MODIFYING THE AGREEMENT FOR THE SETTLEMENT OF OUTSTANDING FINANCIAL QUESTIONS SIGNED ON JUNE 24, 1946

The Polish Ambassador at London to the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs

Sir,

London, 23rd May, 1960.

With reference to the Agreement between the Polish Provisional Government of National Unity and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland for the Settlement of Outstanding Financial Questions signed at London on the 24th of June, 1946⁽¹⁾, I have the honour to propose that the balance of £4,666,669 which remains due to the Government of the United Kingdom from the Polish Government shall be repaid by annual instalments as follows:—

If the Government of the United Kingdom agree to this proposal, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and your reply to that effect should be regarded as constituting an Agreement between the two Governments in this matter which shall come into force immediately.

May I take this opportunity to renew to you, Sir, the assurance of my highest consideration.
