The Polish Ambassador at London to the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs

Sir.

London, 23rd May, 1960.

With reference to the Agreement between the Polish Provisional Government of National Unity and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland for the Settlement of Outstanding Financial Questions signed at London on the 24th of June, 1946(1), I have the honour to propose that the balance of £4,666,669 which remains due to the Government of the United Kingdom from the Polish Government shall be repaid by annual instalments as follows:—
