Bangkok, October 26, 1959.

Monsieur le Ministre,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Royal Thai Government and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland for air services between and beyond their respective territories, signed at Bangkok on the 10th of November, 1950,⁽¹⁾ and also to the following Notes from the Royal Thai Ministry of Foreign Affairs to this Embassy:

No. 21405/2499 of the 14th of July, 1956.

No. 40123/2499 of the 29th of December, 1956.

No. 3022/2501 of the 4th of February, 1958.

No. 10991/2501 of the 25th of April, 1958.

These Notes communicated the agreement of the Thai authorities to the exercise by the British Overseas Airways Corporation of traffic rights at Milan, Istanbul, Beirut and Damascus, and Teheran respectively.

As a result of these changes already agreed, the Government of the United Kingdom propose that Route I of Section I of the Schedule of Routes annexed to the Agreement should be amended to read as follows:

If this proposal is acceptable to the Royal Thai Government I have the honour to suggest that this Note and Your Excellency's reply in that sense should be regarded as constituting an Agreement between the two Governments in this matter which should enter into force immediately.
