Your Excellency,

17 February, 1970.

I have the honour to refer to the Exchange of Notes which took place between the Government of the Republic of Indonesia and the Government of the United Kingdom on March 13th 1969 which it was agreed should be referred to as the United Kingdom/Indonesia (No. 2) Loan 1969⁽¹⁾—Provision of Goods and Services from the United Kingdom, and to further discussions that have recently taken place between our two Governments concerning that loan and to propose that the United Kingdom/Indonesia (No. 2) Loan 1969—Provision of Goods and Services from the United Kingdom should be amended in the following respects:

- a. In the first paragraph Part A the figures "£250,000" and the words "Two hundred and fifty thousand pounds sterling" shall be deleted and replaced by "£183,692 12s. 0d." and "One hundred and eighty three thousand pounds, six hundred and ninety two pounds, twelve shillings sterling".
- b. In the first paragraph Part B (8) the figures "£7,000", "£7,000" and "£5,000" shall be deleted and replaced by "£5,200", "£5,200" and "£1,692 12s. 0d."

In view of these amendments, the Government of the Republic of Indonesia shall by a letter in the form set out at Appendix A to this Note amend the request addressed to the Crown Agents for Oversea Governments and Administrations to open a special account to be styled the United Kingdom/Indonesia (No. 2) Loan 1969 Account and received by them on 18th March 1969.

If the foregoing proposals are acceptable to the Government of the Republic of Indonesia, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note, together with your reply in that sense shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments to amend the United Kingdom/Indonesia (No. 2) Loan 1969—Provision of Goods and Services from the United Kingdom which shall enter into force on the date of your reply.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurances of my highest consideration.
