Sir,

London, December 11, 1969

I have the honor to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland constituted by the Exchange of Notes signed at London on November 26, 1965,⁽¹⁾ relating to the reciprocal granting of authorizations or licenses to permit licensed amateur radio operators of either country to operate stations in the other country.

In view of inquiries that have been made concerning the possibility of extending the application of the above-mentioned Agreement to certain territories, I have the honor to propose on behalf of the Government of the United States of America that the applicability of provisions of the Agreement of November 26, 1965 shall be extended to the territories for whose international relations the Government of the United States of America is responsible and to the territories for whose international relations the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland is responsible listed in the Annex to this Note, and to any other territories which may be notified by the United Kingdom Government to the United States Government.

If the above proposal is acceptable to the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, I have the honor to suggest that this Note and your reply to that effect shall be regarded as constituting an Agreement between the two Governments supplementing the Agreement of November 26, 1965, effective on the date of your reply Note and subject to termination in respect of all or any of their respective territories by either Government giving six months' written notice to the other.

Accept, Sir, the renewed assurances of my highest consideration.
