Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between Japan and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland for Air Services, signed at Tokyo on December 29, 1952,(1) and to propose that the following amendments be made to the Schedule of the aforementioned Agreement as amended on August 22, 1967(2), and June 17, 1969(3):

- 1. In Section I (Routes to be operated by the designated airline or airlines of Japan) of the Schedule, the following route shall be added after route (4):
 - (5) Points in Japan—points in Asia to be agreed—Moscow—points in Europe except the U.S.S.R.—London.
- 2. In Section II (Routes to be operated by the designated airline or airlines of the United Kingdom) of the Schedule, the following route shall be added after route (3):
 - (4) Points in the United Kingdom—points in Europe except the U.S.S.R.—Moscow—points in Asia to be agreed—Tokyo.

If the above proposal is acceptable to the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, I have the honour to suggest that this Note and Your Excellency's reply in that sense shall be regarded as constituting an agreement between the two Governments in this matter which shall enter into force on the date of your reply.

I avail myself of this opportunity to extend to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.
