EXCHANGE OF NOTES

CONCERNING AN INTEREST-FREE LOAN BY THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND TO THE GOVERNMENT OF THE DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF THE SUDAN (UNITED KINGDOM/SUDAN LOAN 1972)

Your Excellency,

12 January, 1972.

I have the honour to refer to the recent discussions concerning development aid from the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the Government of the Democratic Republic of the Sudan and to inform Your Excellency that the Government of the United Kingdom are prepared to conclude an Agreement with the Government of the Sudan in the following terms. The position of the Government of the United Kingdom with regard to the provision of finance and the commitments of that Government and of the Government of the Sudan as regards associated matters shall be as respectively set out in part A and part B below:

- A. The Government of the United Kingdom declare that it is their intention to make available to the Government of the Sudan by way of an interest-free loan a sum not exceeding £1,100,000 (one million one hundred thousand pounds sterling) for the purpose of providing financial assistance towards the costs of four new pumping stations and ancillary equipment needed to recondition existing construction machinery for the first phase of the Northern Province Pump Schemes project (hereinafter referred to as "the Project") and of a Current Meter Calibrating Unit for use by the Ministry of Irrigation and Hydro-electric Power and a Visual Approach Slope Indicator for Khartoum Airport.
- B. (1) The Government of the United Kingdom shall adopt the arrangements and procedures described in the following paragraphs in so far as they relate to things to be done by or on behalf of that Government. The Government of the Sudan shall adopt the arrangements and procedures so described in so far as they relate to things to be done by or on behalf of that Government.

- (2) (a) For the purposes of these arrangements the Government of the Sudan shall, by a request in the form set out in Annex A to this Note, open a special account (hereinafter referred to as the "Account") with a bank in London (hereinafter referred to as "the Bank"). The Account shall be operated solely for the purposes of the loan and in accordance with the instructions contained in the said request.
 - (b) As soon as the Account is opened and before taking any other step required by these arrangements for obtaining any part of the loan, the Government of the Sudan shall furnish the Government of the United Kingdom with a copy of their instructions to the Bank given in accordance with sub-paragraph (a) of this paragraph. The Government of the Sudan shall at the same time and so often as any change is made therein notify the Government of the United Kingdom of the names of the officers who are duly authorised to sign on its behalf the Requests for Drawing Payment Authorities and Payment Orders as set out in Annexes C (ii), D and D (i) to this Note, and shall furnish a specimen signature in duplicate of each such officer.
 - (c) The Government of the Sudan shall ensure that the Bank forwards monthly to the Government of the United Kingdom a statement of receipts to and payments from the Account.
- (3) Save to the extent (if any) to which the Government of the United Kingdom may otherwise agree, drawings from the loan shall be used only:
 - (a) for payments under a contract for the purchase in the United Kingdom (which expression in this Note shall be deemed to include the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man) of goods wholly produced or manufactured in the United Kingdom or, in the case of chemical and allied products, goods which are duly declared to be of United Kingdom origin on the form set out in Annex C (Chemicals) to this Note or, for work to be done or for services to be rendered by persons ordinarily resident or carrying on business in the United Kingdom or for two or more of such purposes, being a contract which:
 - (i) provides for payment in sterling to persons carrying on business in the United Kingdom; and
 - (ii) is approved on behalf of the Government of the Sudan and accepted by the Government of the United Kingdom for financing from the loan; and
 - (iii) is entered into after the date of the signature of this exchange of notes and before 31 March 1973;
 - (b) for reimbursing the Government of the Sudan a proportion of payments made for the Project by them or by an appropriate authority or agency charged with responsibility for the Project towards costs incurred in the Sudan in respect of:
 - (i) the purchase of goods wholly produced or manufactured in the Sudan; or

- (ii) the purchase in the Sudan, with the prior approval of the Government of the United Kingdom, of goods wholly produced or manufactured in the United Kingdom; or
- (iii) the costs of services rendered by citizens of the United Kingdom and Colonies or citizens of the Sudan;
- in such proportion in respect of such goods and services, as are accepted by the Government of the United Kingdom for financing from the loan;
- (c) for reimbursing the Government of the Sudan such proportion as is accepted by the Government of the United Kingdom for financing from the loan of the costs of consultancy services (including the services of architects and quantity surveyors) provided by consultants carrying on business in the United Kingdom and selected in consultation with, and on terms approved by, the Government of the United Kingdom.
- (4) (a) (i) Where the Government of the Sudan proposes that part of the loan shall be allocated to the Project they shall forward to the Government of the United Kingdom through the British Embassy a description of the purposes for which it is required and shall provide such further details as the Government of the United Kingdom may require.
 - (ii) The Government of the United Kingdom shall notify the Government of the Sudan whether their proposal to allocate part of the loan to the purposes described is approved, the amount of the loan approved as provisionally allocated towards the off-shore costs and the local costs (if any), and any special conditions attached to such approval. The amount of the loan finally allocated towards local costs shall not exceed £250,000 (two hundred and fifty thousand pounds sterling).
 - (iii) A firm or firms of consulting engineers whose principal place of business is in the United Kingdom selected with the concurrence of and whose terms of reference have been agreed with the Government of the United Kingdom shall be appointed by the Government of the Sudan to advise them in connection with the Project and to supervise the execution of the Project.
 - (b) Where the Government of the Sudan proposes that part of the loan shall be applied in respect of any particular contract or transaction for the furtherance of the Project, that Government shall, at the earliest opportunity forward to the Government of the United Kingdom:
 - (i) in the case of contracts described in sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph 3:
 - (aa) a copy of the contract or of a notification thereof in the form set out in Annex B to this Note; and

- (bb) two copies of a certificate from the United Kingdom contractor concerned in the form set out in Annex C or Annex C (Chemicals) (whichever is appropriate) to this Note: or
- (ii) in any other case, a letter from the Government of the Sudan identifying the transaction and such information as the Government of the United Kingdom may request.
- (c) The Government of the Sudan shall ensure that the Government of the United Kingdom is informed if at any time a contractor or transaction (being a contract or a transaction in respect of which documents have been forwarded in accordance with the foregoing provisions) is amended or if liability is incurred or is to be incurred thereunder to a greater or lesser amount than the amount specified in the relevant documents so forwarded; and, in any of these cases, the Government of the Sudan shall ensure that there are forwarded as soon as possible to the Government of the United Kingdom the relevant supplementary or revised documents.
- (5) (a) After the Government of the United Kingdom has considered the documents forwarded, in respect of any contract in pursuance of the procedures described in the foregoing provisions of this Note and any additional information which it may request from the Government of the Sudan for this purpose (and which that Government shall then supply), the Government of the United Kingdom shall notify that Government in the form set out in Annex C(i) to this Note whether and to what extent it accepts that a contract or transaction is eligible for payment from the Account.
 - (b) To the extent that the Government of the United Kingdom accepts a contract or transaction and agrees to payment or reimbursement from the Account, it shall, on receipt of a request from the Government of the Sudan, in the form set out in Annex C(ii) to this Note, giving details of the payment due and about to be made, or made, make payments in sterling into the Account and each such payment shall constitute a drawing on the loan.
 - (c) Unless the Government of the United Kingdom otherwise agrees payments into the Account shall not be made after 31 March 1976.
- (6) Withdrawals from the Account shall be made only in the manner and subject to the conditions set out as follows:
 - (a) for payments due under a contract in the cases to which subparagraph (a) of paragraph 3 refers, withdrawals shall be made in accordance with Payment Authorities in the form set out in Annex D to this Note duly signed on behalf of the Government of the Sudan and countersigned by the Government of the United Kingdom. Each Payment Authority shall be forwarded in duplicate to the Government of the United Kingdom for countersignature and shall be accompanied by

Payment Certificates from the contractors concerned in the form set out in Annex E to this Agreement and the invoices (or a photo-copy or duplicate of such invoices) referred to therein for retention by the Government of the United Kingdom; or the invoices only (for retention by the Government of the United Kingdom) relating to contracts in respect of which a Contract Certificate in the form set out in Annex C (Chemicals) to this Note has been provided;

- (b) for reimbursement to the Government of the Sudan in the cases to which sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph 3 refers, withdrawals shall be made in accordance with Payment Orders in the form set out in Annex D (i) to this Note duly signed on behalf of the Government of the Sudan and countersigned by the Government of the United Kingdom. Each Payment Order shall be forwarded in duplicate to the Government of the United Kingdom for countersignature and shall be accompanied by a copy of the invoice from the firm or firms of consultants concerned:
- (c) for reimbursements to the Government of the Sudan in the cases to which sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph 3 refers, withdrawals shall be made in accordance with Payment Orders in the form set out in Annex D (ii) to this Note duly signed on behalf of that Government and countersigned by the Government of the United Kingdom. Each Payment Order shall be forwarded in duplicate to the Government of the United Kingdom for countersignature and shall be accompanied by a claim in duplicate from the Government of the Sudan in the form set out in Annex F to this Note together with a copy of the Consultant's certificate authorising payment.
- (d) Photocopies or duplicates of invoices may be submitted instead of the originals for the purpose of this paragraph.
- (7) If any monies that have been paid out of the Account are subsequently refunded either by the Contractor or by a guarantor, the Government of the Sudan shall, so long as there are payments or reimbursements to be made from the Account, pay an equivalent of such sums into the Account and, in any other case, apply the refunds to the reduction of the loan.
- (8) The Government of the Sudan shall supply to the Government of the United Kingdom an annual statement in duplicate in respect of the Project. The statement shall be countersigned by the appropriate Sudanese audit authority and shall show the loan drawings made for the purposes of sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph 3 of this Note and the actual expenditure incurred during each Sudanese Financial Year; and shall certify that the expenditure was incurred in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in this Note and any condition on which the project or transaction was accepted for financing from this loan. Such statements shall be forwarded to the Government of the United Kingdom as soon as possible and, in any event, not later than twelve months after the end of each Sudanese Financial Year.

(9) The Government of the Sudan shall repay to the Government of the United Kingdom in pounds sterling in London the total sum borrowed under the provisions of this Note, such repayment to be made by instalments paid on the dates and in the amounts specified below; except that if, on the date when any such instalment is due to be paid, there is then outstanding less than the amount specified for that instalment, only the amount then outstanding shall be paid.

- (10) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 9 of this Note the Government of the Sudan shall be free at an earlier time to repay to the Government of the United Kingdom in pounds sterling in London the whole or any part of the loan that is still outstanding.
- (11) The Government of the Sudan shall ensure the provision of such finance additional to the loan finance provided in accordance with the arrangements set out in this Note as may be needed to complete the Project and shall ensure that such finance shall be provided during the same period as the loan finance and in accordance with any programme of disbursement agreed between that Government and the Government of the United Kingdom.
- (12) The Government of the Sudan shall permit officers of the British Embassy and other servants or agents of the Government of the United Kingdom to visit the Project and shall furnish such officers, servants or agents with such information relating to the Project and the progress and financing thereof as the latter may reasonably require.

- (13) Where the loan is used in accordance with paragraph 3 to reimburse the Government of the Sudan a proportion of the costs of employing consultants carrying on business in the United Kingdom, the Government of the Sudan shall either pay in the United Kingdom, or allow to be remitted to the United Kingdom, a reasonable proportion of these costs.
- 2. If the foregoing terms are acceptable to the Government of the Sudan, I have the honour to propose that the present Note and Your Excellency's reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement between the two Governments in this matter which shall enter into force on the date of your reply, and that the loan shall be referred to as the United Kingdom/Sudan Loan 1972.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurances of my highest consideration.

I have to request, on behalf of the Government of the Democratic Republic of the Sudan (hereinafter called "the Government") that you open an account in the name of the Government to be styled as the United Kingdom/Sudan Loan 1972 Account (hereinafter called "the Account").

- 2. Payments into the Account may be made from time to time by Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland. It is possible that, as a result of refunds becoming due from contractors, payments into the Account will also be made by the Government itself.
- 3. Payments from the Account are to be made only against Payment Authorities in the form marked "D" and against Payment Orders in the form marked "D (i)" and "D (ii)" as per attached specimens, duly signed on behalf of the Government and countersigned on behalf of the Government of the United Kingdom.
- 4. You are to send to the Government of the United Kingdom at the end of each month a detailed statement showing all debits and credits to the Account during the month.
- 5. You will notify the Sudan Embassy in London from time to time of the amount required to be drawn from the loan so that the amount so drawn, together with any balance which may be available in the Account, will be sufficient to cover the total value of payments due under Payment Authorities and Payment Orders duly signed on behalf of the Government and countersigned on behalf of the Government of the United Kingdom.
