EXCHANGE OF NOTES

CONCERNING AN INTEREST-FREE DEVELOPMENT LOAN BY THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND TO THE GOVERNMENT OF THE HASHEMITE KINGDOM OF JORDAN

Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the recent discussions concerning development aid from the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan and to inform Your Excellency that the Government of the United Kingdom are prepared to conclude an Agreement with the Government of Jordan in the following terms:—

- 1. The Government of the United Kingdom shall make available to the Government of Jordan by way of an interest-free development loan the sum of £1,435,000 (one million, four hundred and thirty five thousand pounds) sterling towards the execution of the following projects:
 - a. Agaba Airport Project (continuation)
 - b. Amman Electricity (continuation)
 - c. Telecommunications (final)
 - d. Wadi Dhuleil Irrigation Scheme (final)
 - e. University/Hospital Water Supply (first instalment)
 - f. Kerak-Hasa (continuation)
 - g. Irbid Electricity (Stage II) (first instalment)
- 2. The amount made available under this loan shall be repaid by the Government of Jordan to the Government of the United Kingdom in pounds sterling in London, such repayments to be made by instalments paid on the dates and in the amounts specified below:—

INSTALMENTS

Date due	Amount
1 April 1979 and on 1 April in each of the succeeding seventeen years	£41,000
1 October 1979 and on 1 October in each of	
the succeeding 16 years	£41,000 Nil

- 3. Notwithstanding the provision of sub-paragraph 2 above, the Government of Jordan shall be free at any earlier time to repay the Government of the United Kingdom in pounds sterling in London the whole or any part of the loan that is still outstanding.
- 4. Until the monies loaned under the Agreement shall have been expended, the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan shall furnish to the Government of the United Kingdom, through this Embassy, not later than the 30th of June in every year an annual certified statement in duplicate of the expenditure incurred from this loan on each of the projects listed in sub-paragraph 1 above, the first of such statements to be furnished not later than the 30th of June 1975.

If the foregoing proposals are acceptable to the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and Your Excellency's reply in that sense shall be regarded as constituting an agreement between the two Governments in this matter.

Please accept, Your Excellency, the assurance of my highest consideration.
