EXCHANGE OF NOTES

BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF GHANA AMENDING AND EXTENDING THE PUBLIC SERVICE (GHANA) AGREEMENT 1971

- 1. I have the honour to refer to discussions that have taken place between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of Ghana concerning the continuance of the Public Service (Ghana) Agreement 1971(1) (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement") and certain matters related to passage costs thereunder and to propose that the Agreement be amended as follows:
 - 1. In sub-paragraph 4 (a) of paragraph 1 delete the words "inducement allowance" and substitute the words "salary supplement".
 - 2. Following sub-paragraph 4 of paragraph 1 add a new sub-paragraph 5A as follows:
 - "5A. The Government of the United Kingdom will meet the cost of providing for designated officers and their dependant families passages on such occasions (not being occasions referred to in paragraph 5B below) as the Government of Ghana may, with the prior concurrence of the Government of the United Kingdom, prescribe. Passages for designated officers and their dependant families should be by British carrier and when practicable by excursion or charter flight".
 - 3. Re-number sub-paragraph "5" of paragraph 1 as "5B".
 - 4. In sub-paragraphs 6 and 7 of paragraph 1 delete the word "allowances" and substitute the words "salary supplement, allowance".
 - 5. In sub-paragraph 11 of paragraph 1 delete the words and figures "31st March 1976" and substitute the words and figures "31 March 1981".
- 2. If this Note correctly sets out the terms that have been agreed, I have the honour to propose that this Note and your reply shall constitute an Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great

Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of Ghana which shall enter into force on 31 March 1976 and which shall be cited together with the Agreement as the Public Service (Ghana) (Continuance) Agreement 1971/76.
