EXCHANGE OF NOTES

BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE AMENDING THE AIR SERVICES AGREEMENT OF 12 JANUARY 1971

Excellency,

27 May, 1976.

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Republic of Singapore for Air Services between and beyond their Respective Territories, signed at Singapore on 12 January 1971(1), and to recent discussions which have taken place between representatives of the two Governments concerning proposed amendments to the Schedule annexed thereto.

As a result of these discussions, it was agreed that the Schedule should be amended as follows:

- (a) the addition of "Penang" between "Bangkok" and "Kuala Lumpur" in column 2 of Route II of Section I
- (b) the deletion of the words "both" and "and United Kingdom Route II" from Note 1 of Section I
- (c) the addition of "Kaohsiung" before "Taipeh" in column 4 of Route II of Section II.

If the foregoing is acceptable to the Government of the Republic of Singapore, I have the honour to propose that this Note and Your Excellency's reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement between the two Governments in this matter which shall enter into force on the date of Your Excellency's reply.
