#### United Kingdom/Pakistan Debt Relief Agreement 1976

1. I have the honour to refer to discussions between the Government of the United Kingdom and the Government of Pakistan under the terms of the Memorandum of Understanding on Debt Relief for Pakistan dated 28 June 1974 (hereinafter referred to as "the Memorandum")(1). I propose, to give effect to that Memorandum in as far as it concerns matters under the control of our two Governments, an agreement as follows:

#### Debt service payments 1 July 1974-30 June 1978

2. The Government of the United Kingdom has calculated the total service payments due on debts as defined in paragraph 3(b) of the Memorandum. Summary details of the sums included in this calculation are set out in Annex 1 to this Agreement. The total service payments falling due in each of the Pakistan financial years between 1 July 1974 and 30 June 1978 inclusive are shown in row 8 of the table at Annex 1. The total aid debt service payments and the total commercial debt service payments falling due in each of the Pakistan financial years between 1 July 1974-30 June 1978 are shown in rows 4 and 7 respectively at Annex 1 to this Agreement.

#### **Debt relief**

- 3. After applying the percentages agreed in paragraph 3 (b) of the Memorandum as amended at the consortium meeting in Paris on 29 April 1976, the amounts of relief due to be provided by the Government of the United Kingdom in each of the Pakistan financial years between 1 July 1974-30 June 1978 are as set out in row 10 of the table at Annex 1 to this Agreement.
- 4. The Government of the United Kingdom in a manner fully consonant with the terms of the Memorandum is prepared to provide relief on terms which will reflect an overall average grant element to the Government of Pakistan of at least 62 per cent of all relief, when calculated from 1 July of the year for which the relief is provided.

#### **Debt settlement**

5. Pakistan has been relieved of the liability for aid debt incurred for projects visibly located in Bangladesh and the provisions of relevant loan Agreements stand modified to the extent the aid debts listed in Annex 2 have been reduced.

#### Arrangements for payment of debt relief

- 6. The Government of Pakistan shall resume payment in pounds sterling in London with effect from 1 July 1976 of all sums falling due for debt service on:
  - (i) The United Kingdom/Pakistan credit agreements (hereinafter referred to as "the Section III loans"), financed by the Export Credit Guarantee Department of the United Kingdom (hereinafter referred to as "the ECGD").
  - (ii) the United Kingdom/Pakistan loan agreements (hereinafter referred to as "the ODM loans"), financed by the Ministry of Overseas Development (hereinafter referred to as "the ODM").
  - (iii) the sums falling due under the terms of the first short term aid debt rescheduling arrangement dated 30 November 1972 and the second short term aid debt rescheduling arrangement dated 29 June 1974.

The debt service payments included under (i) and (ii) above shall be made in accordance with the instalments, on the dates and in the amounts set out in Annex 2 to this Agreement. The debt service payments included under (iii) above shall be made in accordance with the instalments, on the dates and in the amounts set out in Annexes 3 and 4 of this Agreement.

- 7. The Government of Pakistan shall ensure that commercial debt service payments are made to the United Kingdom commercial creditors listed in Annex 5 to this Agreement, in accordance with the terms of the relevant contracts. The provisions of Annex 6 shall apply to the repayment of the commercial debts therein mentioned. The rights and obligations of the individual creditors, debtors and guarantors concerned shall not be affected by this Agreement.
- 8. The Government of the United Kingdom shall make funds available to the Government of Pakistan to the value of the relief due on the aid debt service payments and the relief due on the commercial debt service payments for the Pakistan financial years 1976/77 and 1977/78, in the following amounts and on the following dates:

In determining the amounts of the funds to be made available to the Government of Pakistan, the Government of the United Kingdom has taken account of the relief already taken by the Government of Pakistan with respect

to aid debt-servicing (see row 11 (i) of the table at Annex 1). Account has also been taken of the relief already taken and due to be taken in respect of pre-1974 commercial credits in the period 1 July, 1974 to 30 June, 1978 (see paragraph 7 above and row 11 (ii) of table at Annex 1 to this Agreement). If in any year the relief provided or taken has fallen short or was in excess of the amount due, a compensating excess or shortfall, after allowing for a discount of 10 per cent from the year of the original excess or shortfall, shall be provided in the following year (or years). No repayment of relief already taken on aid debt-servicing amounting to £5 808 million for 1974-75 and £7 492 million for 1975-76 nor repayment of the amounts of £6 117 million and £5 021 million to be made available as specified in this paragraph shall be made by the Government of Pakistan.

#### Conclusion

- 9. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as limiting the Government of Pakistan in:
  - (a) entering into discussions with the Government of Bangladesh concerning the transfer to the Government of Bangladesh of any external debt liability which the Government of Pakistan considers was incurred for the benefit of areas now under the jurisdiction of the Government of Bangladesh, and which it therefore regards as the liability of the Government of Bangladesh provided that, if any such transfer is made, it shall not affect the rights of any creditor without its consent with respect to the Government of Pakistan; or
  - (b) claiming compensation from the Government of Bangladesh or from other beneficiaries in Bangladesh for payments already made or to be made by the Government of Pakistan, in servicing any such debt.
- 10. Certain figures in Annex 5 (page 5) to this Agreement are not final as some of the loans are subject to variable interest rates. Moreover the percentage of relief to be provided will remain provisional until the IBRD have established the exact amounts of all the relevant debts due to all the countries participating in the debt relief exercise. The Government of Pakistan and the Government of the United Kingdom shall consider at the end of the debt relief period the need to make, retrospectively, adjustments to relief given on the basis on the actual debt service payments made.
- 11. The Annexes to this Agreement shall form an integral part thereof; provided that such Annexes and the Agreement may be subject to the terms of paragraph 3 (b) of the Memorandum of Understanding dated 28th June, 1974, and paragraph 10 of this Agreement. Any consequent amendment shall be arranged by mutual Agreement between our two Governments.
- 12. If the foregoing proposals are acceptable to the Government of Pakistan, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note together with your reply shall constitute an Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom and the Government of Pakistan which, save for the provisions of Annex 6 which shall come into force on a date to be notified by

the Government of the United Kingdom to the Government of Pakistan,(2) shall come into force on the date of your reply and which shall be known as the United Kingdom/Pakistan Debt Relief Agreement 1976.

Except in the case of the PICIC loan, which has a fixed interest rate of 7 per cent the interest payments on all the loans have been provisionally calculated at 8 per cent + 1.25 per cent margin for 1976-77 and 1977-78. However, the interest rates, except in the case of PICIC, are variable and will be determined by application of a formula of LIBOR + margin. The conversion from dollars into sterling has been calculated at the IMF representative rate of US\$2.3885 = £1.

#### ANNEX:6

#### PAYMENT OF COMMERCIAL DEBTS

#### ARTICLE 1

#### **Definitions**

In this Annex unless the contrary intention appears:

- (a) "Creditor" shall mean a person or body of persons or corporation resident or carrying on business in the United Kingdom or any successor thereto who has supplied from outside Pakistan goods or services under or in relation to the contracts listed in the Schedule to this Annex:
- (b) "Debt" shall mean any debt to which, by virtue of the provisions of Article 2 of this Annex, the provisions of this Annex apply;
- (c) "Debtor" shall mean any person listed as such in the Schedule to this Annex;
- (d) "Moratorium interest" shall mean the interest payable under the provisions of Article 3 of this Annex;
- (e) "The Department" shall mean the Export Credit Guarantee Department of the United Kingdom or any other Department which the Government of the United Kingdom may nominate for the purposes of this Annex;
- (f) the singular shall include the plural and vice versa.

#### ARTICLE 2

#### The debts

The provisions of this Annex shall apply to the debts of principal and of contractual interest falling due on or before 30th June 1974 as listed in the Schedule to this Annex, and which remain unpaid.

#### ARTICLE 3

#### Moratorium Interest

The Debts shall bear Moratorium Interest which shall be calculated on a day-to-day basis at the rate of 6 per cent per annum on the outstanding amount of each Debt from the date on which the debt originally fell due.

#### ARTICLE 4

#### **Payment**

The Government of Pakistan shall pay to the Creditors in sterling in the United Kingdom the outstanding amounts of the Debts and Moratorium Interest on 1st July 1978.

#### ARTICLE 5

## Exchange of information

The Department and the State Bank of Pakistan shall exchange all information required for the implementation of this Annex.
