Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Extradition Treaty between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Republic of Finland signed at London on 29 October 1975⁽¹⁾.

In accordance with Article 2(1) (a) of the said Treaty and further to the Notes exchanged at Helsinki on 12 May 1976⁽¹⁾ which extended the Treaty to certain territories for the international relations of which the Government of the United Kingdom are responsible, I now have the honour to propose that the Treaty be extended additionally to the Solomon Islands.

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Republic of Finland, I have the honour to propose that this Note together with Your Excellency's reply in that sense shall constitute an Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Republic of Finland, which shall enter into force three months after the date of this Note, that is to say on 28 April 1977.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.
