OF THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GOVERNMENTS
OF THE MEMBER STATES OF THE
EUROPEAN COAL AND STEEL COMMUNITY,
MEETING WITHIN THE COUNCIL, OF 29 JUNE 1976
EXTENDING THE PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF THE DECISION OF
26 JUNE 1975 OPENING TARIFF PREFERENCES FOR PRODUCTS
COVERED BY THAT COMMUNITY AND ORIGINATING IN ISRAEL

The Representatives of the Governments of the Member States of the European Coal and Steel Community, meeting within the Council,

Whereas pending the entry into force of the Agreement between the Member States of the European Coal and Steel Community and the State of Israel,⁽²⁾ signed on 11 May 1975, the Representatives of the Governments of the Member States adopted autonomously and concomitantly Decision 75/373/ECSC of 26 June 1975 opening tariff preferences for products covered by that Community and originating in Israel;⁽²⁾ whereas that Decision is applicable until 30 June 1976 at the latest;

Whereas the said Agreement has not yet entered into force, and whereas the period of validity of the autonomous measures should be extended for six months;

In agreement with the Commission,

Have decided as follows:

ARTICLE 1

The date 30 June 1976 in Article 4 of Decision 75/373/ECSC is hereby replaced by the date 31 December 1976.

ARTICLE 2

Member States shall adopt all the measures necessary for the implementation of this Decision.
