**EXCHANGE OF NOTES  
BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF  
GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE  
GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA  
FURTHER AMENDING THE SCHEDULE ANNEXED TO THE  
AGREEMENT FOR AIR SERVICES BETWEEN AND  
BEYOND THEIR RESPECTIVE TERRITORIES,  
SIGNED AT JAKARTA ON 28 JUNE 1973**

Note No. 123

Her Britannic Majesty's Embassy present their compliments to the Department of Foreign Affairs and have the honour to refer to the agreement signed at Jakarta on 28 June 1973<sup>(1)</sup> between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Republic of Indonesia for air services between and beyond their respective territories, and following discussions held in London on 5 and 6 May 1981 between representatives of the aeronautical authorities of our two countries, to propose in accordance with article 11 of the agreement the following amendments to the route schedule attached to the agreement as amended by the exchange of notes of 14 November 1979<sup>(2)</sup>. In Section 1, replace route 1 with the following:

London—A point in Europe—a point in the Middle East (including the Gulf)—

A point in the Indian Sub-Continent—Colombo—Bangkok—Kuala Lumpur—Singapore—Jakarta—Points beyond.

In Section 2 replace route 1 with the following:

Jakarta—Singapore or Kuala Lumpur—Bangkok—Colombo or Bombay or Karachi—A point in the Middle East (including the Gulf)—  
Three points in Europe—London—Points beyond.

If these proposals are acceptable to the Government of the Republic of Indonesia, the British Embassy have the honour to propose that this note and the Government of Indonesia's reply in that sense shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments in this matter which shall enter into force on the date of the Government of Indonesia's reply.

Her Britannic Majesty's Embassy avail themselves of this opportunity to renew to the Department of Foreign Affairs the assurance of their highest consideration.
