Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Independent State of Papua New Guinea for the Promotion and Protection of Investments signed at London on 14 May 1981<sup>(1)</sup> and to propose that, in accordance with the provisions of Article 11, the Agreement shall extend to Hong Kong, the Bailiwicks of Jersey and Guernsey, and the Isle of Man.

If this proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Independent State of Papua New Guinea, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and Your Excellency's reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement between the two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of Your Excellency's reply.

I avail myself of this opportunity to extend to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.
