Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the United Kingdom/Turkey (Gemlik Ammonia Plant) Loan Agreement 1976<sup>(1)</sup> (hereinafter referred to as "the Loan") and to inform you that my Government intends that the amount to be made available to your Government by way of a loan will be reduced by the sum of £1,219,872.34 (One million, two hundred and nineteen thousand, eight hundred and seventy-two pounds, 34 pence sterling).

2. Accordingly, I have the honour to propose that the figures and words "£4,000,000 (Four million pounds sterling)" in paragraph 2 of the Loan be deleted and the figures and words "£2,780,127.66 (Two million seven hundred and eighty thousand and one hundred and twenty-seven pounds 66 pence sterling)" be substituted therefor and that the schedule under "INSTALMENTS" in paragraph 21 of the Loan be deleted and the following be substituted therefor:

<i>Date due</i>	<i>Amount</i>
1 July 1984 and on the 1 July in each of the succeeding 17 years . . . . .	£77,225.77
1 January 1985 and on the 1 January in each of the succeeding 16 years . . . . .	£77,225.77
1 January 2002 . . . . .	£77,225.71

3. If the proposals set out above are acceptable to your Government, I have the honour to propose that the present Note together with Your Excellency's reply in that sense shall constitute an Agreement between the two Governments, which shall enter into force on the date of Your Excellency's reply, amending the United Kingdom/Turkey (Gemlik Ammonia Plant) Loan Agreement 1976.

4. I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.
