Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the "Eurocontrol" International Convention relating to Co-operation for the Safety of Air Navigation signed at Brussels on 13 December 1960<sup>(1)</sup>, which established Eurocontrol (hereinafter called the Organisation). Discussions have been taken place concerning the application of social security provisions established by the law of the United Kingdom, and I have the honour to inform you that the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland wish to propose that the Director-General and staff of the Organisation, if they are not British citizens and not permanently resident in the United Kingdom, shall, with respect to services rendered for the Organisation, enjoy exemption from the provisions of any social security scheme established by the law of the United Kingdom.

If this proposal is acceptable to the Organisation I have the honour to propose that this Note, together with your reply in that sense, shall constitute an Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Organisation which shall enter into force immediately before the date on which the Protocol amending the Convention, which Protocol was opened for signature on 12 February 1981<sup>(2)</sup>, enters into force<sup>(3)</sup>.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurances of my highest consideration.
