Sir:

I have the honor to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland for Financing Certain Programs of Educational and Cultural Exchange, signed at London on the 10th of May, 1965^{1,2,3}. On the instructions of my Government I have the honor to propose that, in accordance with Article 15 of the Agreement, an amendment be made by adding, in Article 5, a new paragraph (h) to read as follows:

(h) Purchase, acquire, hold and dispose of real property and undertake, enter into, or assume mortgage obligations necessary for the purchase or acquisition of real property.

If the foregoing proposal for amendment is acceptable to the Government of the United Kingdom, I have the honor to suggest that this Note together with your reply in that sense shall be regarded as constituting an agreement between the two Governments amending the said Agreement with effect from this day's date.

Accept, Sir, the renewed assurances of my highest consideration.
