AMENDMENT¹ TO THE STATUTE OF THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE
CERTIFICATE OF THE SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE

(ARTICLE 41, PARAGRAPH *d*, OF THE STATUTE)

Whereas paragraph *d* of Article 41 of the Statute of the Council of Europe provides that amendments to Articles 23-35, 38 and 39 which have been approved by the Committee of Ministers and the Parliamentary Assembly shall come into force on the date of the certificate of the Secretary General, transmitted to the governments of members, certifying that they have been so approved,

The Secretary General hereby certifies as follows:

1. The Committee of Ministers, by the adoption on 24 March 1999 of resolution (99) 4 fixing the number of Representatives of Georgia in the Parliamentary Assembly, approved the amendment to Article 26 of the Statute, the text of which is set out below;
2. The Parliamentary Assembly had approved the same amendment on 27 January 1999 (Opinion No. 209 (1999));
3. Both organs of the Council of Europe having thus approved it, the amendment comes into force this 27th day of April 1999, being the date of this certificate, transmitted on the same date to the governments of members.

The amended text of Article 26 is worded as follows:
