# EXCHANGE OF NOTES EXTENDING THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF MONGOLIA FOR THE PROMOTION AND PROTECTION OF INVESTMENTS SIGNED AT ULAANBAATAR ON 4 OCTOBER 1991 TO THE ISLE OF MAN AND THE BAILIWICKS OF GUERNSEY AND JERSEY

The British Embassy at Ulaanbaatar to the Ministry of External Affairs of Mongolia.

Her Britannic Majesty's Embassy present their compliments to the Ministry of External Relations of Mongolia and have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of Mongolia for the Promotion and Protection of Investments done at Ulaanbaatar on 4 October 1991<sup>1</sup> and in accordance with the provisions of Article 12 thereof, propose that the Agreement shall be extended to the Isle of Man, and the Bailiwicks of Guernsey and Jersey.

If this proposal is acceptable to the Government of Mongolia, the Embassy have the honour to suggest that the present note and the Ministry's reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement between the two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of the Ministry's reply.

Her Britannic Majesty's Embassy avail themselves of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of External Relations the assurance of their highest consideration.
