

EXCHANGE OF NOTES ON REVISED ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN DEBTS DUE FROM THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF CHILE TO THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND

Your Excellency

I have the honour to refer to discussions between representatives of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and representatives of the Republic of Chile concerning the agreement constituted by letters exchanged on 3 December 1963(¹) and known as the United Kingdom - Chile Credit Agreement 1963 (hereinafter called "the Credit Agreement"), and to inform Your Excellency that the United Kingdom are prepared to conclude an agreement with the Republic of Chile in the following terms:—

- 1. The United Kingdom shall not require the Republic of Chile to make any further payments in respect of sums which fell due or which shall have fallen due during the period from 1 January 1973 to 31 December 1974, both dates inclusive, pursuant to promissory notes issued in accordance with the provisions of the Credit Agreement.
- 2. The Republic of Chile shall pay to the Export Credits Guarantee Department of the United Kingdom or any other department which the Government of the United Kingdom may nominate for the purposes of this Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "the Department") the sums specified in the Annex to this Note on the dates stated therein.
- 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 2 of this agreement, the Republic of Chile may pay to the Department the principal amount of any sum referred to in that paragraph, or any part thereof, before its due date together with all the interest accrued thereon up to the date of receipt by the Department of such principal amount.

If the foregoing proposals are acceptable to the Republic of Chile I have the honour to suggest that the present Note together with your Excellency's reply in that sense shall constitute an agreement between the Republic of Chile and the United Kingdom which shall enter into force on the date of your reply.
