M. Carlin to the Marquess of Lansdowne.--(Received February 5.

Londres, le 3 Février, 1903.

By direction of my Government I have the honour to inform your Lordship that, on the 8th January, 1903, the Empire of Corea acceded to the Geneva Convention of the 22nd August, 1864, for the amelioration of the condition of wounded soldiers in armies in the field (Red Cross).
