THE UNITED KINGDOM AND SIAM

RELATIVE TO

TAXATION ON LAND HELD OR OWNED BY BRITISH SUBJECTS IN SIAM.

In order to facilitate the financial arrangements of the Siamese Government, and on condition that taxation on land rented, held, or owned by British subjects, shall nowhere exceed taxation levied on similar land in Lower Burmah, Her Britannic Majesty's Government consent to the abrogation of the Schedule of Taxes in five sections annexed to the Supplementary Agreement between Great Britain and Siam, signed at Bangkok, May 13th, 1856. Siamese Majesty's Government having assented to the above condition, the Undersigned, Her Britannic Majesty's Chargé d'Affaires in Siam, and His Siamese Majesty's Minister for Foreign Affairs, duly authorized to that effect, have agreed as follows:—

1. The words "The taxes here alluded to are those set forth in the annexed Schedule" appearing in Article IV of the Agreement supplementary to the Treaty of Friendship and Commerce between Siam and Great Britain, signed at Bangkok, May 13th, 1856, shall be and are hereby deleted.

2. The Schedule, in five sections, of taxes on garden, ground, plantations, and other lands, annexed to the above-mentioned

Agreement, shall be and is hereby abrogated.

In witness whereof the Undersigned have signed the same in duplicate, and affixed thereto their seals at Bangkok on the twentieth day of September, in the year one thousand nine hundred of the Christian era, and in the one hundred and nineteenth year of Ratnakosindr.
