*Her Majesty's Ambassador at Oslo to the Norwegian Minister
for Foreign Affairs*

Your Excellency,

June 30, 1953.

I have the honour, upon instructions from Her Majesty's Prime Minister, to propose that the Monetary Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Norwegian Government of the 6th of November, 1950,⁽¹⁾ which was reviewed last year in accordance with Article 8 of the Agreement, shall continue in force so long as bilateral balances between the United Kingdom and Norway are settled through the European Payments Union, provided that either Government may terminate the Agreement constituted by this Exchange of Notes at any earlier date on giving to the other three months' notice of its intention to do so.

If the Norwegian Government agree to this proposal, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and your Excellency's reply in that sense shall be regarded as constituting an agreement between the two Governments.
