The United States Acting Secretary of State to Her Majesty's Ambassador at Washington.

Department of State,

Excellency, Washington, December 2, 1956.

I have the honor to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland relating to air services between their respective territories, signed at Bermuda on February 11, 1946,(1) and subsequent amendments,(2) and to inform you that in accordance with Article 8 thereof the Government of the United States proposes that Section III of the Annex to the Agreement be amended by adding "Barbados" to the third column of Route 12, Section III (b) ("Routes to be served by Air Carriers of the United States") and by adding "Barbados" to the first column of Route 4, Section III (a) ("Routes to be served by Air Carriers of the United Kingdom").

If the additions to Section III of the Annex as set forth above are agreeable

If the additions to Section III of the Annex as set forth above are agreeable to the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, I suggest that this Note and your reply thereto should constitute an Exchange of Notes, for which Article 8 of the Agreement provides.
