EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF INDONESIA AMENDING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ANNEXED TO THE EXCHANGE OF NOTES OF JULY 2, 1956, ABOUT ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE EXPORT OF COTTON YARN AND/OR TEXTILES FROM HONG KONG TO INDONESIA

Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Exchange of Notes of the 2nd of July, 1956,(1) and the Memorandum of Understanding annexed thereto constituting an Agreement for the supply of cotton textiles to Indonesia against raw cotton to be obtained by Hong Kong from the United States and to inform you that in exercising their right to re-allocate certain unfulfilled quotas the Government of Indonesia proposes to increase the quota for Hong Kong and that the Memorandum of Understanding should be amended in the following manner:-

- (a) In clause 1A "U.S. dollars 3.5 million" shall read "U.S. dollars 6 million" and
- (b) In clause 1H the period of "six months" shall read "nine months".

If this proposal is acceptable to the Government of Hong Kong I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and your Excellency's reply in that sense should be regarded as constituting an Agreement between the Government of Indonesia and the Government of Hong Kong, acting with the consent of the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, amending the said Memorandum in accordance with the terms of paragraphs (a) and (b) above.
