AMENDMENT TO THE STATUTE OF THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE⁽¹⁾

An Amendment to Article 26 of the Statute of the Council of Europe was approved by the Committee of Ministers on May 28, 1961, and by the Consultative Assembly on September 21, 1961. The Amendment came into force on November 3, 1961, and the text in English and French is given below:
