Monsieur le Ministre,

*Kuwait, June 2, 1963.*

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the State of Kuwait's Note Verbale of the 20th of December, 1962, and earlier correspondence between the Ministry and Her Britannic Majesty's Embassy mentioned therein, referred to the Air Services Agreement of the 24th of May, 1960,<sup>(1)</sup> between the Government of Kuwait and the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

In consequence of these exchanges and in conformity with Article 11 (1) of the said Agreement, I have the honour, on the instructions of Her Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, to propose to Your Excellency that Route 1 of Section I of the Schedule to the Air Services Agreement of the 24th of May, 1960, should be modified to read as follows:—

“(1) London–Dusseldorf or Frankfurt–Zurich or Geneva–Rome–Istanbul or Beirut or Damascus or Amman or Cairo–Baghdad or Abadan–Kuwait–Bahrain–Doha–Karachi and beyond.”

Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom would be ready, at the same time, to agree to a corresponding modification of Route (1) of Section II of the Schedule to the aforesaid Agreement, to read as follows:—

“(1) Kuwait–Abadan or Baghdad–Cairo or Damascus or Beirut or Istanbul–Tripoli (Libya) or Rome–Geneva or Zurich–Frankfurt or Dusseldorf or Hamburg–Nice or Paris–London.”

I am instructed to propose further that this Note and Your Excellency's reply should constitute a formal amendment to the Schedule to the aforesaid Agreement agreed between the Contracting Parties, as provided in Article 11 (1) thereof, and should come into effect on the date of this Exchange of Notes.

I confirm that the Government of Kuwait is desirous of making the corresponding modifications of Route (1) of Section II of the Schedule to the aforesaid Agreement to read as follows:—

“(1) Kuwait–Abadan or Baghdad–Cairo or Damascus or Beirut or Istanbul–Tripoli (Libya) or Rome–Geneva or Zurich–Frankfurt or Dusseldorf or Hamburg–Nice or Paris–London.”

I have the honour further to inform Your Excellency that the Government of Kuwait will regard Your Excellency's Note of today's date and the present reply as constituting a formal amendment to the Schedule to the Air Services Agreement of the 24th of May, 1960, in accordance with Article 11 (1) thereof and that such amendment shall come into effect on the date of this Exchange of Notes.
