AMENDMENT TO THE STATUTE OF THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE⁽¹⁾

An Amendment to Article 26 of the Statute of the Council of Europe was approved by the Committee of Ministers on 30 April, 1965, and by the Consultative Assembly on 3 May, 1965. The Amendment came into force on 24 May, 1965, and the text in English and French is given below :
