Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Republic of Peru for Air Services between and beyond their respective Territories, signed at Lima on the 22nd of December, 1947⁽¹⁾, as amended by the Exchange of Notes on the 3rd and 16th of February, 1961⁽²⁾, and to inform you that the Government of the United Kingdom propose that Route 1 of Schedule I to the Agreement should be amended by the substitution in (b) of "Points in the Bahamas" for "Nassau".

If this proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Republic of Peru I have the honour to suggest that this Note and Your Excellency's reply in that sense should be regarded as constituting an Agreement between the two Governments which shall take effect immediately.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.

Tengo a honra avisar recibo a Vuestra Señoría de la atenta nota (1381/65 nº 85), fechada en el día de hoy, que expresa lo siguiente:

"Tengo el honor de referirme al Convenio entre el Gobierno del Reino Unido de Gran Bretaña e Irlanda del Norte y el Gobierno del Perú, sobre servicios aéreos entre y más allá de sus respectivos territorios.

firmado en Lima el 22 de Diciembre de 1947, según fue enmendado por los cambios de Notas del 3 y 16 de Febrero de 1961; e informar a Vuestra Excelencia que el Gobierno del Reino Unido propone que la Ruta 1 del Plan I de ese Convenio, sea enmendado por la Substitución en (b) de "puntos en las Bahamas" en lugar de "Nassau"."
