I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Inter-Governmental Maritime Consultative Organization regarding the Headquarters of the Organization, signed at London on 28 November 1968,⁽¹⁾ (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement") and to propose that Article 10 of the Agreement be amended as follows:

- to paragraph (1) add "(g) vehicle excise duty."
- in paragraph (2) delete "sub-paragraphs (a) to (f) of paragraph (1)" and insert "sub-paragraphs (a) to (g) of paragraph (1)".

If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Inter-Governmental Maritime Consultative Organization, I have the honour to propose that this Note, together with your reply in that sense, shall constitute an Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Inter-Governmental Maritime Consultative Organization which shall enter into force on the date on which the United Kingdom legislation giving effect to the amendment comes into operation.⁽²⁾
