Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand for the Promotion and Protection of Investments signed in London on 28 November 1978⁽¹⁾ and to inform the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand that the Government of the Turks and Caicos Islands have confirmed that they wish the provisions of this Agreement to be extended to their territories. In accordance with the provisions of Article 1 of the Agreement the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland accordingly wish to propose that the Agreement shall be extended to the Turks and Caicos Islands.

2. If this proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and Your Excellency's reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement between the two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of Your Excellency's reply.

3. I avail myself of this opportunity to extend to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.
