Dear Secretary,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and His Majesty's Government of Nepal for the Promotion and Protection of Investments done at Kathmandu on 2 March 1993 and, in accordance with the provisions of Article 12 thereof, to propose that the Agreement shall be extended to the Isle of Man, and the Bailiwicks of Guernsey and Jersey.

If this proposal is acceptable to His Majesty's Government of Nepal, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and your reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement between the two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of your reply.
