The Secretary of State for Foreign and Commonwealth Affairs to the Director of the International Oil Pollution Compensation Fund

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the International Oil Pollution Compensation Fund regarding the Headquarters of the Fund, signed at London on 27 July 1979 (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement").¹

- 2. I now have the honour to propose that a new Article be inserted in the Agreement after Article 8(2) as follows:
- "(3) The Fund shall be accorded a refund of Insurance Premium Tax and Air Passenger Duty paid by the Fund in the exercise of its official activities."
- 3. If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the International Oil Pollution Compensation Fund, I have the honour to propose that this Note, together with your reply in that sense, shall constitute an Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom² and Northern Ireland and the International Oil Pollution Compensation Fund which shall enter into force on the date on which the United Kingdom legislation giving effect to the amendment comes into force.
