By direction of my Government, I have the honour to inform your Lordship that, in a note dated the 13th March last, the Mexican Department for Foreign Affairs has announced to the Swiss Federal Council the accession of the United States of Mexico to the Geneva Convention of the 22nd August, 1864, for the amelioration of the condition of the wounded in armies in the field. On the 24th June the said Department forwarded to the Federal Council a copy of the Decree by which the Mexican Senate has, on the 25th April, 1905, approved this accession.
