I have the honour, by direction of my Government, to inform your Excellency that, by a note dated the 8th July last, the Venezuelan Ministry of Foreign Affairs forwarded to the Swiss Federal Council the Act of Accession of the United States of Venezuela to the Geneva Convention of the 6th July, 1906, for the amelioration of the condition of the wounded and sick in armies in the field.

Venezuela having acceded on the 9th July, 1894, to the Geneva

Convention of the 22nd August, 1864, its accession to the Convention of the 6th July, 1906, is subject to no other condition.
